Data privacy

Your data, which you enter in the registration form, will be used by us exclusively for the event organisation and will not be passed on to third parties.

Participant selection

Young people from the member states of the Council of Europe and Israel aged 16 to 27 years inclusive may participate. Persons who need a recommendation for leave from school, training centre or university for the day of arrival and departure, please contact the organiser.

Registration is open between August 27 and September 17, 2018. We will send you a binding confirmation of participation or a waiting list on September 25, 2018. Your registration is only binding upon receipt of the final confirmation of participation.

We strive for a heterogeneous seminar group with regard to gender, age, participation context, state, etc. If more registrations are received than are available, they will be placed on a waiting list and distributed in the event of cancellations by confirmed participants accordance with the above criteria.

Accommodation

Arrival and check-in will take place on November 9 between 16:00-19:00, departure and checkout on November 12. Participation in the EUROPEAN FOR PEACE Youth Conference is free of charge. The costs for three nights from November 9-12, 2018 incl. breakfast, lunch and dinner are covered. The overnight stay takes place in 2-3 bed rooms. Bed linen and a towel are provided. Tea, coffee and water will be provided during the event.

The house rules of the wannseeFORUM Foundation must always be followed. In the event of infringements, the organiser reserves the right to exclude the relevant participants from the event. In this case, travel expenses may not be covered, and claims for damages may also be asserted.

Cancellation/Non-appearance for the event

If you are unable to attend the first EUROPEANS FOR PEACE Youth Conference, please email us immediately. In the event of a short-term cancellation (14 days before the event) of participation or early departure on the part of the participants side, the organiser reserves the right not to reimburse or invoice any travel and accommodation costs incurred. Participation in the entire event is obligatory. A signature is required on arrival.

In the event of illness, a medical certificate must be sent by scan to leskien@wannseeforum.de, in which case no further costs will be incurred. Travel expenses cannot be reimbursed by us. Please check the general terms and conditions of the transport company (airline/train company).

Declaration of consent; Right of Privacy & Publicity

All participants under 18 years of age must have a declaration of consent to participate in the event signed by a legal guardian. This must be sent as a scan to leskien@wannseeforum.de by October 26, 2018. The original must be brought to the event. Participation is not possible without proof of consent. The declaration of consent also includes the consent or refusal to use the photographs and films made about you for documentation and advertising purposes.

All participants from the age of 18 years must sign a declaration of consent or refusal to use the photographs and films taken about them for documentation and advertising purposes. This document must be completed on the day of arrival.

Travel Expenses

We will reimburse the travel costs for the round trip of all participants. The completed travel expense accounting should be submitted at the seminar venue or to the EVZ Foundation until four weeks after the conference (until December 10, 2018). Please keep all original vouchers (tickets, boarding cards, invoices etc.). If you need to exchange money in order to purchase tickets, please also keep the vouchers documenting the exchange rate of your exchange. Travel expenses cannot be reimbursed without proof of the costs incurred or in the event of late submission.

All participants should consider additionally: For travelling in Germany only costs for travelling by train (second-class) can be reimbursed. Travelling by plane or car (0,20 euros per kilometer / max. 130 euros for outward and return journey) can only be reimbursed if these costs are cheaper than traveling by train or if no other traveling routes are available. We also encourage you to use the train within Germany for environmental reasons. A trip with the carpool is only possible if you submit a receipt signed by the driver as proof. We cannot reimburse taxi or rental cars costs.

The costs for public transport in Berlin are only covered in connection with arrival and departure. This means you can pay a maximum of 2x3,40€ (6,80€ in total) for your ABC-tickets. Status: Price of the BVG tariff products April 2018.

We would like to ask you to book your own tickets for your arrival and departure. In the Single Euro Payment Area (SEPA-countries), travel expenses can be reimbursed by bank transfer. For participants from Israel, Russia, Belarus, Ukraine, Macedonia and Georgia we would like to arrange the travel booking for you – we will contact you if this is the case.
